Euroopa Komisjoni ettepanek keelustada jahipidamine
ja kalastamine 10% Euroopa Liidu maa-alal

Täname Eesti Jahimeeste Seltsi tehtud ettepaneku eest Euroopa Komisjoni juhendmaterjali eelnõule: *Draft Technical Note on Criteria and Guidance for Protected Areas Target*, mida tutvustati NADEG töörühmas 22. oktoobril ja millele oodati kommentaare 15. detsembrini 2020.

Saatsime oma kommentaarid dokumendile 15. detsembril. Arvestades sealhulgas teie ettepanekut kommenteerisime rangelt kaitstavatel aladel jahipidamise ja kalapüügi keelustamist järgnevalt:

„On the basis of the Commission guidance in strictly protected areas all kind of fishery and hunting activities will be automatically banned, even though these activities may not affect negatively the conservation objectives of the areas (e.g. bottom structures and species are protected but pelagic (no bottom contact) trawling is also banned). As these activities are conducted usually on a small scale, they do not harm the natural functioning of protected areas.

In another hand it is highlighted that non-intrusive energy installation and tourism may be allowed in strictly protected areas. We, in principle, agree that restrictions of activities in strictly protected areas should be analysed and evaluated case by case. It should be the competence of the MS to allow or disallow these activities depending on the conservation objectives.

As such fishing and hunting is linked to important social, ecological and recreational values of land use, we propose that sustainable fisheries and sustainable hunting should not be forbidden a priori in the strictly protected areas, but only if the conservation objectives of the area require that“.
