ONE WITH NATURE

By organising the “One With Nature” World of Hunting and Nature Exhibition, **Hungary intends to present nature conservation in a genuine and modern manner** to the Hungarian and international public through examples of game, fish and forest management.

The motto of the series of events is also expressive: “One With Nature” indicates that **humanity is part of nature; its fate depends on the terrestrial biosphere**, which must therefore be protected, and the regenerative capacity of which must be maintained. The priority goal of the Exhibition is to draw people’s attention to **the importance of preserving nature and the purpose of the sustainable use of nature**, and for them to acknowledge the usefulness and need for disciplines which are close to nature: hunting, game management, fishing, angling, fish management, forestry and forest management.

The “One With Nature” World of Hunting and Nature Exhibition aims to have something for everyone! The World Exhibition will provide joy and experiences to everyone who is open to the resonances of nature. Welcoming children and families is of especial importance. The Exhibition will also speak to the younger generation: it will present to even the youngest visitors the fact that humankind and nature are inseparable from each other.



HUNGEXPO

INTERNATIONAL HALL

PAVILION “A”, 19 528 m²

Presentation of countries and international organisations. This hall will be home to the World Conservation Forum, which will discuss a diverse range of topics in the spirit of sustainability.

CONFERENCES

PAVILION “C”, 5 800 m²

The fantastic new conference center will host a wide range of professional and scientific events, including a nationally organised – but internationally focused – hunting conference, overviewing the issues of wildlife management, professional experiments, solutions and innovations.

PRESENTATIONS

OUTDOOR AREAS

Each hall will have an outdoor area for presentations which demand more space. These will mainly be related to the themes of horses and hunting, hunting dogs and traditional weapons, but it should be noted that the main routes and squares will be the scene of a continuous cultural festival with performances and concerts, creating a real buzz.

FISH, WATER, MANKIND

PAVILION “D”, 5 580 m²

In this hall we will be presenting the centuries-old relationship between fish, water and mankind. Aquaria will cover an area of 719 m² and contain a total of 1 million liters of water, in which we will be able to admire 2,000 specimens of some 50 different species of fish.

TRADITIONAL HUNTING METHODS

PAVILION “F”, 3 838 m²

The main topics of the pavilion: the relationship between horses and hunting, archery, falconry, dogs and hunting, and hunting with muzzleloader rifles. Visitors can experience an adventure trail of traditional hunting methods, and this will also be the venue for a presentation on the cfight of professional hunters against poaching.

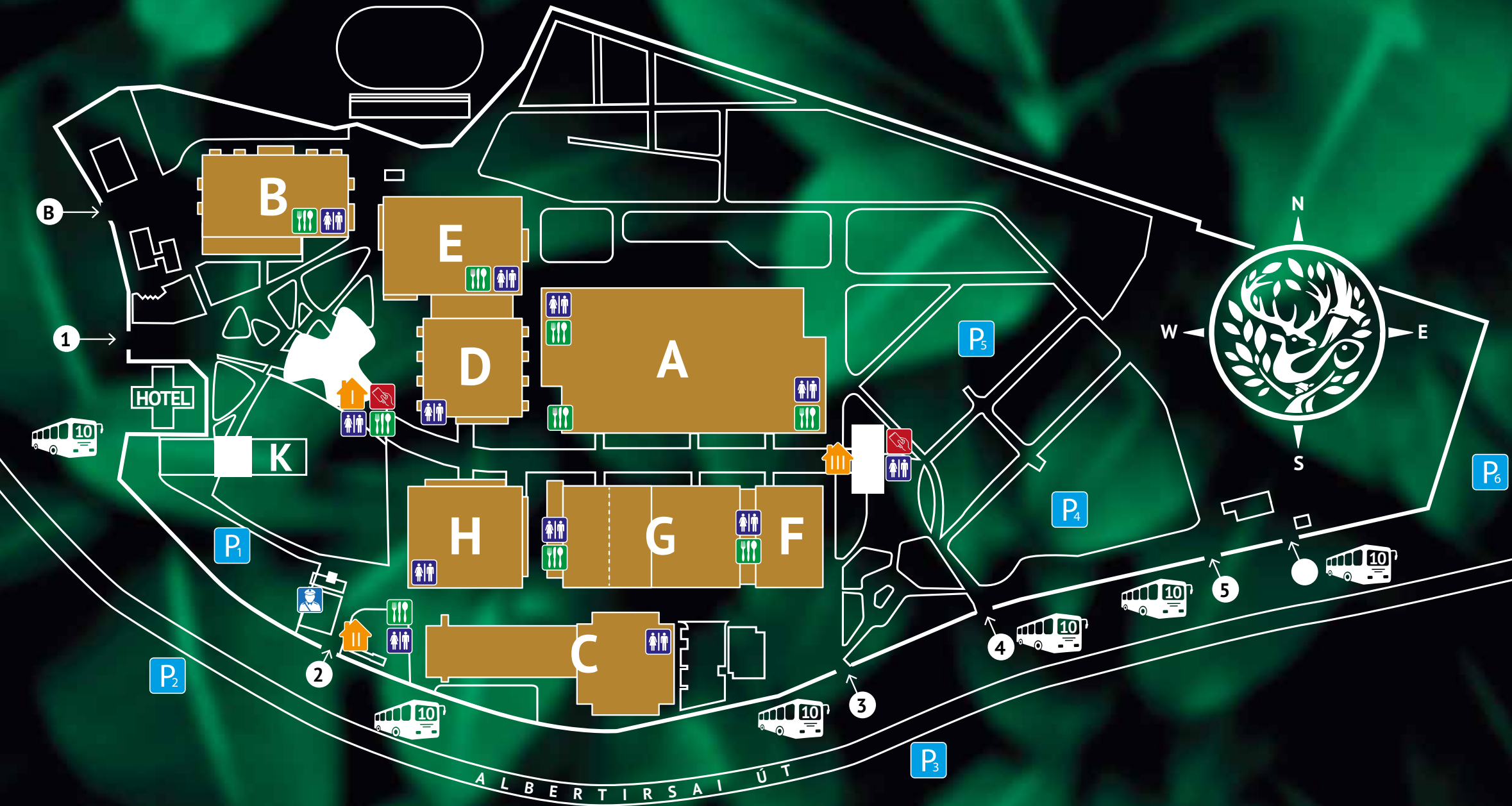
PAVILION “G”, 4 500 m²

There will be continuous **special show kitchens, demonstrations and on-site catering services**, in addition to which street food will also receive special emphasis. And all this will be exclusively within the realm of fish and game! The same will be true for the foods and menus available from establishments operating within the pavilions themselves, while in the VIP area visitors will be able to sample the menu offered by Bocuse d'Or.
